# Regular Reminders

We have a **pre-loved uniform** rail available in the school library that anyone can utilise free of charge however if you would like to make a donation, please use the QR code found on the rails.

As per the national guidance, please ensure that if your child has suffered from any aspect of **vomiting or diarrhoea** that they stay away from school for at least **48 hours** from the last episode.

**Should I keep my child off school?**

**Yes** Until...

- Chickens:** at least 7 days from the onset of the rash and until all lesions have crusted over.
- Diarrhoea and Vomiting:** 48 hours after their last episode.
- Cold and Flu-like Illness (including COVID-19):** they no longer have a high temperature and have had enough to drink, follow the COVID-19 guidance if it is a viral illness (COVID-19).
- Herpes:** their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics.
- Measles:** 4 days after the rash has appeared.
- Mumps:** 5 days after the swelling started.
- Skin Lesions:** they've had their first treatment.
- Sudden Fever:** 24 hours after they started taking antibiotics.
- Whooping Cough:** 48 hours after they started taking antibiotics.

**No** but make sure you let their school or nursery know about...
