alongside the Easter raffle organised by the Friends of Wymondley. Natalie from FoW shared the wonderful news that last week's



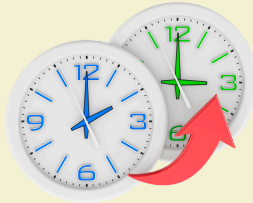
Book Fair raised a fantastic £175.70 for books for the school.
