NHS **Should I keep my child off school?**

Yes

Checklist:

- Children: At least 1 day from the start of the illness and all of their symptoms have gone
- Children and Young People: At least 48 hours after their last episode
- Adults and Young People: They no longer have a high temperature and their cough/soil has cleared. Return to school only if you're feeling better for 24-48 hours after they started work/studied or 48 hours after they started work/studied or 48 hours after they started work/studied.
- Vegetables: 4 days after their last episode
- Meat: 5 days after their last episode
- Sauces: 5 days after their last episode
- Supper Food: 24 hours after their last episode
- Wholesome Gravy: 48 hours after their last episode

- Teething: Irritated anus
